

TOWN OF SPRINGDALE PUBLIC HEARING

PROPOSED AMENDMENT TO MUNICIPAL PLAN AND DEVELOPMENT REGULATIONS

The Town of Springdale has adopted amendments to its Municipal Plan and Development Regulations to give Council discretionary authority to



allow chickens to be kept for domestic use on residential properties. The amendments will add **“keeping of chickens”** as a discretionary use in the Residential Low Density and Residential Medium Density zones.

A Public Hearing to consider objections or other comments on the proposed amendments will be held at the Springdale Town Hall at 7:00 p.m., Thursday, February 1, 2024.

The proposed amendments and corresponding Urban Chicken Regulations can be viewed at the Town Office during normal office hours and on the Town’s website - www.townofspringdale.ca.

Anyone who wishes to comment on the amendments shall submit to the Town a written statement or email outlining their objection or other representation. If no submission is received by 3:30 p.m., Tuesday, January 30, 2024, the Public Hearing may be cancelled.
